artFix, Soho's newest art space dedicated to making the arts fun, affordable and more accessible is encouraging music lovers to come and celebrate Record Store Day 2015 with them at the artFix space, 27 Peter Street W1F 0AJ.

On Saturday 18 of April Berwick Street will be hosting a music festival, and artFix will be celebrating this unique festival by hosting a range of free live acts on site from 11am-9pm.

The artFix program is packed with live events from photographers, painters,

Dj's and dancers.

During the day, two artists will be inspired to create live-art by whatever is happening around Soho on Record Day. Marta Corada, a Spanish artist from La Rioja who mainly works with photography manipulation, whether it's digitally, through a collage or manual drawing will be creating works live. Along side Marta Corada artists Ed Firth, an animator and artist, who makes and mixes live animated and video visuals, draws beards, and designs motion graphics will be also working his artistic magic in the artFix space. Both artists will be creating their own impression of Record Day and displaying it in the artFix space live.

ArtFix also presents live Dj sets that will be taking place, presented by Flow 2 The Floor records, in various styles including funk, soul, afro beat and house tunes. On the decks audiences will enjoy Dj J Hart, Y-etizm and The New Neighbours.

In the evening our regular 'Chop Shop' event starts where music enthusiasts can expect to experience a live beat making session by Micall Parkinsun. Handcrafted beats will be produced from random records on the spot. This is an impro session not to be missed.

'Chop Shop' is a free event that will run from 5 to 9pm, also in the artFix space, and is said to attract like-minded people who love records, samples and music production. 'Chop Shop'
